Joyce F. Kelly Huffman born Jan 24, 1933 (Mother Ora Barrett and grandfather Frank Barrett) writes:

Her teachers were Lloyd Cooper and Ruby Harris. Her dad worked as a carpenter, farmer, minister and her mom worked as a homemaker. Classmates were Willard Hovis, Freeman Huffman and Bernice Gipson. Took notes told by Elmer Gipson age 89 on 6-12-99. He remembers Buckhorn looking like a busy community with Crawford General Store and Post office, a 2-room school, 2 churches. There was a swinging bridge over the creek between the school and store. Claude Murry ran the black smith shop. Before Crawford built the store there was a store across from the school (across creek) Ike and Ola Pugh's Gen Store and post office and seed and feed store and gas pump. Their son's name was Curtis Pugh. On Saturday Willie Darnell came in the store to cut hair (there was a barber chair in there). Their house was next door to the store. In front of the store there was a hitching post for horses. Fate Barrett rode his horse to the store one day then went home (about two miles) with friends in a buggy. In the middle of the night he

woke up and remembered and went back to get his horse, Molly. He is the father of Frank Barrett. There was a black smith down by the Lord's house and down by the bridge where the creeks join there was a gristmill. Parts of the stone and dam can still be found .

Clifford Myers born 1-1-26 was born at Desloge and went to Buckhorn school between 1934 and 1938. His teachers were Silas Dees and Ethel Hinkle. His father farmed, saw milled, and worked in lead mines. He liked to hang out at the creek. His classmates were Aubrey Myers, Elenora Gipson Sanders, Alta Gipson, Bob Krueger, and June Johnson. Our school was a 2 room white building we called one room the little room (grades K-4 and the other the big room (5-8). We had rows of desks, oiled wooden floors, a big wood stove in each room, and a water bucket was in the back of the room. Each pupil was supposed to have a cup. Rest room facilities were two outside toilets. A toilet for the girls and one for the boys. A well with a pump was near the schoolhouse. We played ball, jump rope and other games that required no equipment. We ate our bucket lunch on the roots of the big oak trees on the school ground.

Simple Tag Games, and Cat and Mouse. These are the one's that Florence Whitener checked. The list included some 30 different game names as: Ruth and Jacob, Baste the Beetle, Bird catcher and Herr Slap Jack. She also listed visitors that came twice in a group. Some of the other pages in the school record books show how long the teacher studied, improvements and additions to the school, what the needs are as maps etc and if the teacher planned on returning for the next year.
