

I love this picture. It shows the love of music my Grandmother Lessie and Grandfather Sid Whitener had and shared with their seven children. Florence Johnson always talked about the evenings that she, Roy, Lessie and Sid would get in front of the pump organ (still working thanks to Phil Senter) and sing with the guitar, organ, violin and mandolin. I also see a side of my Grandfather Sid laying down in front.

This picture also shows the custom of long ago, when a visiting minister and his wife, visited the area and taught music and harmony to areas. I haven't taken time to see what song is above their head.

The names of the singers are listed but there is some confusion when we have more women's names in one row and when you know some of their names, something doesn't match. The names are written on the back but some are hard to read. I also noted that they are wearing the same white dresses and pins as in a graduation photo on previous page. Another part of this picture shows a number of the ladies married the men in the photo.
